




ButoVal - Turning bushland into the future

The agricultural output of Namibia's savannahs has shrunk by two thirds in recent decades. The reason for this is the scrub encroachment of the grassland. The excessive spread of thorny bushes deprives animals, plants and people of their valuable natural habitat. The cheetah is a species of particular concern, and there are many other animal and plant species that suffer from scrub encroachment.

The BMBF project ButoVal (Bush to Value), in which we as DHG are playing a leading role, has now introduced a plant that can effectively process bush biomass. The new bush wood utilisation plant processes bundled bales of cuttings and thus prepares the material for further processing. Possible downstream products from this biomass include biochar and charcoal, wood pellets, wood chips or biodiesel.

In this way, resources that can be used sustainably can be obtained. For rural regions in particular, the production of bush biomass means opportunities for energy supply, labour, education and development. In addition, once the bushes have been thinned out, the land can once again be used for grazing and fodder. This benefits local agriculture in several ways.

This is how economic progress can be created from an ecological problem.

We are a pioneer for sustainable premium charcoal from Namibia

We produce sustainable charcoal from the invasive bushwood that overgrows the natural savannah landscapes in Namibia.

A large proportion of the bushwood consists of acacia, a particularly dense and heavy wood that has excellent properties for charcoal production. Thanks to its high density, it glows evenly and for a particularly long time, produces little smoke and burns out without leaving much residue. We, DHG, support the Namibian scrub clearance project together with our partners. We produce our high-quality barbecue charcoal from the surplus bushwood that is obtained so people can enjoy relaxed barbecues with environmentally-friendly premium barbecue charcoal.

No forests or rainforests are cut down to produce our coal which also makes an important contribution to the rewilding of natural savannah landscapes. We work closely with the FSC® and use this certification to ensure selective bush harvesting. Valuable species and sites are selected, documented and protected. Our supply chain is 100 % transparent and guarantees that each individual bag can be traced right down to a few hectares of land. The charcoal is produced and packaged in Namibia. The entire value-added process remains in the country and creates many secure jobs. All parties involved in our supply chain are audited by amfori BSCI.



That is why we were the first company in this sector to calculate our emissions together with IFAS from Campus Birkenfeld, Germany's greenest university - both on a company level and on a product level, in order to continue decarbonising our value-added chain. The amazing thing is that our charcoal products remove CO₂ from the atmosphere right along the supply chain, from the moment the wood is harvested to the point it is charred and then transported to our factory gate in Wachtendonk.

DHG and EIFEL-HOLZ have been producing and distributing peat-free substrates together for many years and are working intensively on innovative peat replacement products. The preservation of peaty moorlands guarantees that their CO₂-storing properties are maintained, making an essential contribution to climate protection.

We are constantly developing our formulas and technology. We carry out essential testing and research in order to support end consumers and commercial horticulture with high-yield products for peat extraction. We are leading the way with our own substrate brands: BIOTERRA® is our greenest substrate brand, 100 % peat-free and organic. With EIFELHUM® and HUMOFLOR®, we are on the right track and are offering more and more peat-free and low-peat products. We now produce over 3.2 million bags of 100 % peat-free soil for our customers every year (2025) – a figure that we are proud of and that is increasing every year. Over 50 % of this comes from our own EIFEL-HOLZ plant in East Belgium.

Green and close to the raw material of the future.

EIFEL-HOLZ played a key role as a pilot partner in the development of the certification process for the HORTICERT seal. HORTICERT is an international certification system designed to safeguard ecological, social and qualitative sustainability criteria for peat substitutes, potting soils and growing media. It guarantees that the certified products meet the highest ecological, social and quality standards and offer a genuine alternative to substrates containing peat.

We generate the electricity for our production ourselves from renewable sources, and even the waste heat from production is utilised efficiently. The forestry and woodland industry in the beautiful West Eifel region provide us with many valuable raw materials in the immediate vicinity. All of this creates short delivery and transport routes and optimises the carbon footprint of our products.

Located in the Belgian part of the Eifel region, we have been producing bark products and growing media of the highest quality since 1989. In 2023, we were able to put our new, state-of-the-art production hall with 12 production

lines into operation. With an impressive raw material warehouse, state-of-the-art mixing technology and efficient packaging capacities, EIFEL-HOLZ is one of the most powerful plants in Europe.

Our main components from our own production.

We are proud to guarantee quality assurance through our in-house raw material production. At EIFEL-HOLZ, the green waste compost is produced from the initial raw material all the way to its final application, as are the substrate humus and the substrate fibre. The substrate humus, consisting of regional softwood bark, is RAL quality assured and matures for up to 9 months on our factory premises. Our own substrate fibre production is characterised in particular

by refiner technology. This enables us to produce a very structurally stable wood fibre with low nitrogen immobilisation, which is perfect for longer cultivation periods. Our greatest strength is having the entire production process from A-Z in our own hands, on our own premises. We only buy in components that cannot be produced regionally, such as coconut fibre. This gives us the confidence to produce even particularly large-volume ranges reliably and on schedule for you.





